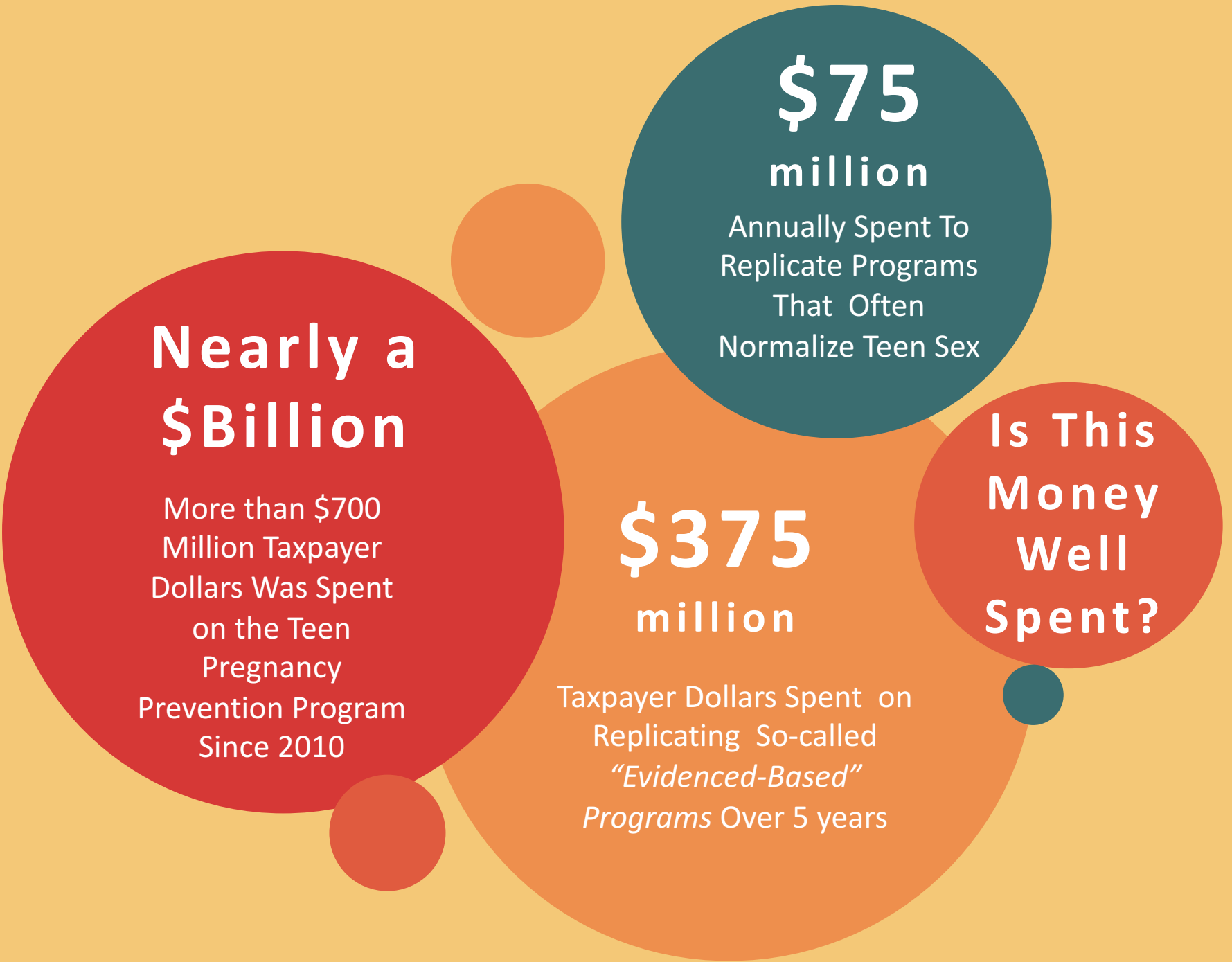

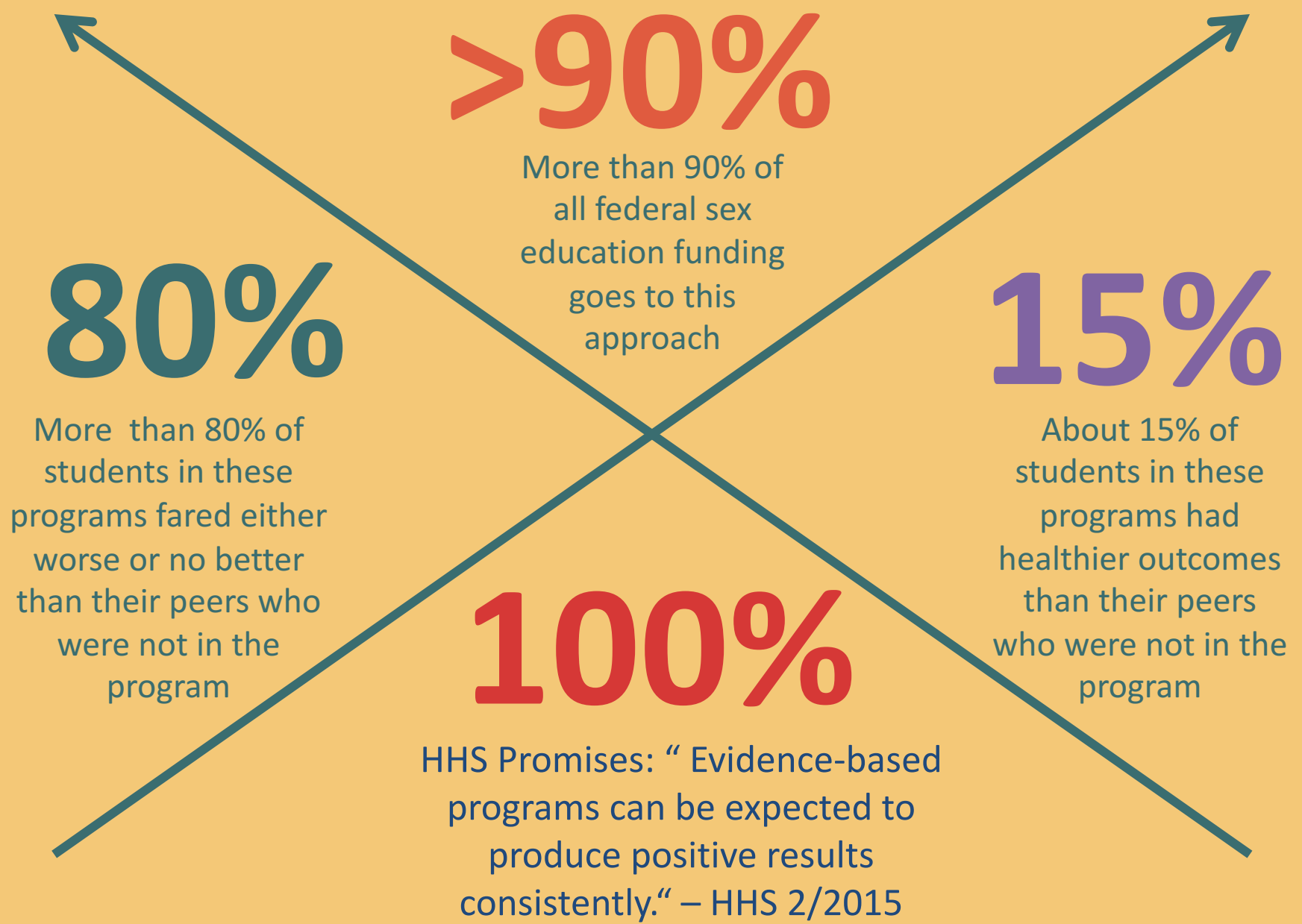
Report of Teen Pregnancy Prevention Programs



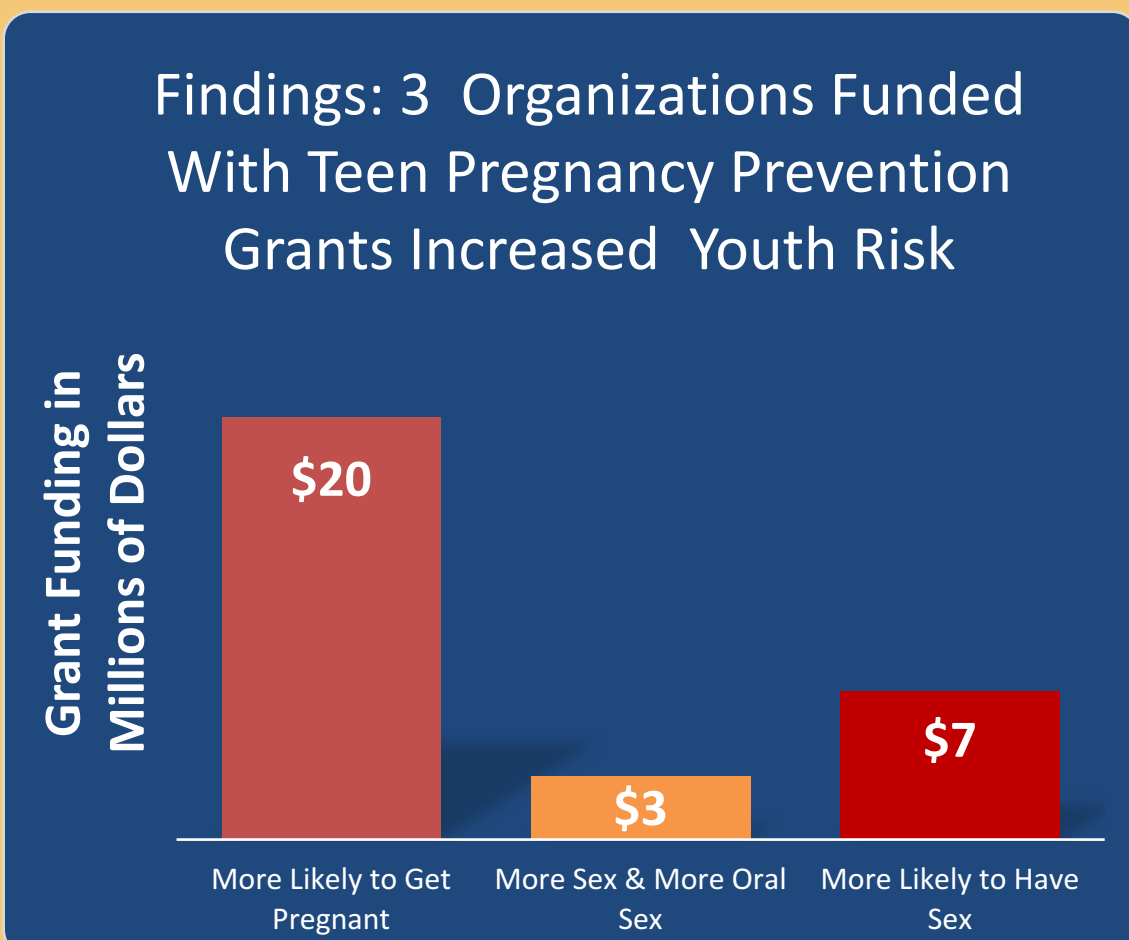
\$375 million dollars & 5 years of Teen Pregnancy Prevention (TPP) programs show that the purported "Evidenced-Based" programs aren't showing much evidence of effectiveness.



"...most of the programs had small or insignificant impacts on adolescent behavior." – Am. Journal of Pub. Health, 9/2016



Newly released research gauged the effectiveness of the Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program from 2010-2014. In some cases, students were more likely to engage in risky behavior as a result of their participation in the program.
